

 Database Fundamentals - Gain a solid understanding of database structure types and the ability to develop, modify and run code, providing the groundwork for database administrators to gather, store, and drive data assets.



- **Database Deployment** Compare and contrast the various aspects of database planning and design and explain the various phases of the implementation, testing, and deployment of collected data.
- **Database Management and Maintenance** Understand the purpose of monitoring and reporting database performance, explain common database maintenance processes, and produce critical documentation.
- Data and Database Security Secure databases, protect against attacks, and control authorization while ensuring
 governance and regulatory compliance.
- Business Continuity Prepare for and recover from incidents by implementing best practices for backup and restoration
 of data.

U.S. Data Market Stats

- The median salary for database adminstrators is \$102,530.
- There were more than 23,400 job postings by US employers for Database Administrators during the 12-month period April 2022 -March 2023.
- Employers listed more than 2.1 million job postings in the US seeking candidates with database related skills over the 12-month period ending March 2023. (i.e., these skills are important to many other roles.)
- Database Administrators are found in virtually every industry. In May 2021, the median annual wages for database administrators in the top industries in which they worked were as follows:
 - Computer systems design and related services \$114,950
 - Management of companies and enterprises \$107,700
 - Computing infrastructure providers, data processing, web hosting, and related services \$106,950
 - Colleges, universities, and professional schools \$87,680
 - Insurance \$108,700

Database Administrator Job Role Stats

- At nearly double (or 2x) the national estimated growth rate, tech jobs are projected to be among the fastest-growing occupations over the 10-year period 2023-2033.
- The need for Database Administrators will continue to grow, reaching about 163,000 by 2033. The 10-year projected growth rate for Database Administrators is 35% above the national rate.
